Free attractions

- Riccarton Rotary Market, Sunday morning (weather dependent).
- Christchurch Cathedral: Free guided tours available 11.30am Friday and Sunday, 11.00am Saturday. Small fee to climb the tower.
- Canterbury Provincial Chambers: Free guided tours 10.00am and 3.00pm or by prior arrangement.
- Our City O-Tautahi: Life and issues of Christchurch presented via exhibitions.
- Mall Experience: City Mall, The Strip, Westfield, Eastgate, The Palms and Northlands.
- Riccarton Bush, Deans House and Mona Vale: Self guided tour, any day (weather dependent).
- Winery Tour: Any day of Convention.
- Craft shop tour: Saturday only.
- Victoria Park, Sign of the Kiwi, Governor's Bay (lunch), Summit Road, Sumner (café), Lyttelton, including timeball station, Quail Island, return via tunnel (full day).
- Air Force Museum (half day).
